**VILLAGE OF WIND POINT VOTING INFO**  
**Partisan Primary Election Tuesday, August 13**

A Partisan Primary election is just around the corner on Tuesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. Races on the ballot will include primaries for United States Senate, US Representative in Congress District 1, Wisconsin Representative to the Assembly District 62, Racine County District Attorney, Racine County Clerk, Racine County Treasurer, Racine County Register of Deeds, and two State Referendum. Please note that in a partisan primary, you may vote in only one party section. If you designate a party preference, votes cast in that party section will be counted; votes cast in any other party section will not be counted. If you do not designate a party preference, and you vote in more than one party, no votes will be counted.

**Absentee Voting – by mail**

Electors wishing to receive an absentee ballot by mail may do so by submitting an [Absentee Ballot Application](#). Absentee ballots need to be returned by election day in order to be counted. The deadline for making an application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is 5 pm on the fifth day before the election, August 9, 2024.

**Absentee Voting – in-person**

In-person absentee voting is available at the Village Office 2 weeks before Election Day during normal business hours, Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The first Day and Hours to Vote in the Clerk's office is July 30, 2024, and the last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is Friday, August 9, 2024.

**Voter Registration**

Residents needing to register or re-register to vote can do so by mail, online, or in person at the Village Office or at the polls on election day. For more information, and to check your current registration status, visit <https://myvote.wi.gov>

All exterior changes need prior approval from the ARC and WMC Board of Directors. This applies to **ALL** homes in Wind Meadows. These changes include, but are not limited to, changing the color of your single-family home or roof, satellite dish or solar installation, window or patio door changes, deck or patio modifications, replacement or changes to landscaping around your home as well as swing set/trampoline/playhouse additions, to name a few. If you have any questions, contact the WMC office.
